



2010-2011 Highlights

- “Dinners for Eight” hosted in community homes from April to July 2010
- Garage sale fundraiser, community picnic hosted by Larry & Kathy Gilliam in July
- M’pact fundraising concert for music program August 2010
- Music Jam at Lindberg home in August
- Name changed August 29 from **Center for Spiritual Awakening** to **Center for Spiritual Living - Olympia**
- Two Sacred Circle series offered (one in fall and one in late winter)
- Formation of a Sacred Circles facilitators team, with eleven facilitators
- Three terms of certificated Science of Mind classes taught: two Foundations classes, Treatment & Meditation, Visioning, Edinburgh Lectures
- An integrated six-week pledge drive program offered
- Children’s program doubled in size from an average of six children to up to 17 children a Sunday, under Camille Fastle’s guidance, who took over as the director of the children’s program in September of 2010
- Special Singing Bowls Service offered in August, produced by Barbara Metcalf (with ice cream social) with record attendance of 150 people
- The Singing Bowls return in November and for a March concert produced by Barbara Metcalf and Camille Fastle, raising \$500
- Julie Baker (with help from Camille Fastle) hosts volunteer awards banquet and the team re-invents Sunday Lobby experience
- Choir begun for holiday season led by Denny Kautzmann and it’s such a success it now meets every Sunday
- The use of projector screen with computer slides is begun in September by Denny Kautzmann (with help of Michael Stuart, Carol Kautzmann, Marylin Ball-Brown)
- Sunday volunteer teams and layout of foyer redesigned by new Volunteer Team Leader, Buffie Finkel; many new volunteers added
- Under Karyn Lindberg’s leadership, Kinship Family project aids a family during holidays
- Potlucks go monthly, last Sunday
- Membership/Information class held monthly on the second Sunday of the month
- Membership grew from 56 members to 64
- Sunday attendance grew from 58-65 to 85-117 – averaging 91.5 people per Sunday
- Volunteer Fair in January nearly doubles active participation as new people sign up
- Barbara Hart, RScP, offers free four-week prosperity class after service – over 30 people attend each Sunday
- Prayer shawl team, under Caroline Fenn’s leadership, meets monthly and has given 30 shawls in the past two years
- Members filled 50 Christmas stockings for the Thurston County Food Bank
- Announcement inserts designed and created by Terry McLellan become a regular feature of the Sunday bulletin
- Website redesign and relaunch by Sherry Nelson, implementing the branding style of United Centers for Spiritual Living
- Created the Floor Manager position, filled wonderfully by Doug Pape, “go to guy”
- Meditation in separate room established in September
